Many critics of Emily Bronte's novel *Wuthering Heights* see its second part as a counterpoint that comments on. If it does not reverse, the first part, where a romantic reading receives more confirmation. Seeing the two parts as a whole is encouraged by the novels sophisticated structure, revealed in its complex use of narrators and time shifts.

Granted that the presence of these elements need not argue for an authorial awareness of novelistic construction comparable to that of Henry James, their presence does encourage attempts to unify the novels heterogeneous parts. However, any interpretation that seeks to unify all of the novels diverse elements is bound to be somewhat unconvincing. This is not because such an interpretation necessarily stiffens into a thesis but because *Wuthering Heights* has recalcitrant elements of undeniable power that ultimately, resist inclusion in an all-encompassing interpretation. IN this respect, *Wuthering Heights* shares a feature of *Hamlet*
